PUBLIC NOTICE

It has come to the notice of this office that a number of vehicle owners residing in this district are operating vehicles purchased from outside the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir without completing the mandatory process of re-registration, despite the fact that No Objection Certificates (NOCs) have already been issued by the concerned Transport Authorities.

Operating such vehicles without re-registration is a violation of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, and results in administrative challenges as well as enforcement difficulties for the authorities.

Accordingly, all such vehicle owners of District Kishtwar are hereby informed through the medium of this notice to **complete the re-registration of their vehicles within 15 days** from the issuance of this notice.

Failure to comply shall invite strict legal action, which may include:

- **Seizure of the vehicle, and**
- **Penal action under the relevant provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act.**

All concerned are advised to adhere to this notice in order to avoid any inconvenience.
